Subject: Recommendation Federal Lobbying Services

**RECOMMENDATION:** That a firm fixed price contract in the amount of \$72,000 a year be awarded to Cardinal Infrastructure to provide Connect Transit Federal Lobbying Services. The period of the contract will have a base period of three (3) years.

**BACKGROUND:** Connect Transit will be applying for discretionary capital and planning grants to fund projects such as bus replacements and transfer point infrastructure. Federal lobbying services will help increase our return on federal dollars through grants and programs, legislation, and regulatory actions. The lobbying services will help Connect Transit maintain and develop relations with our Congressional delegation and Federal agencies to promote and protect the interest of Connect Transit.

**DISCUSSION:** Two (2) proposals were received from the following vendors: Cardinal Infrastructure and Carmen Group. The proposals were scored based on the following criteria: 40% Qualifications and Experience, 40% Scope of Work, and 20% Cost Proposal.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** Funds for this agreement will come from local share account. The total cost of the three year contract is \$216,000.
