We are excited to roll-out Commute with Connect, our newest service to the Bloomington-Normal area. Every day, approximately 35,000 people drive to B-N from surrounding areas to work. Even with these numbers, many employers are challenged with hiring enough employees to meet their needs.



Connect Transit recognizes that the cost of owning a car, including the initial purchase, maintenance, insurance, fuel, etc. can be prohibitive to some people who would like to have the employment opportunities that exist in B-N. Existing commuters are seeing their paychecks impacted by the increased cost of their commute and it is affecting their purchasing power for other goods and services.

Enter – Commute with Connect...

Commute with Connect is a coordinated vanpool program available to people who live outside of B-N and wish to access jobs in B-N. The program coordinates people with similar work shifts going to similar areas who are interested in riding together, and provides them a sponsored van to get to work and back home again.

Commute with Connect

Once four or more people are matched, a vanpool coordinator will contact the group to begin working out the details. One person from the group will volunteer to be the primary driver and will be responsible for daily driving. The vanpool group will pay a monthly fee that will include the vehicle, insurance on the vehicle, cleaning, maintenance, and roadside assistance.



The cost of fuel is shared by the group and coordinated separately. This is a great program for smaller employers who do not have the resources to manage their own program, as well as larger employers who can save staff hours, insurance, and vehicle costs of providing this service themselves. In addition, employers benefit from a reduced need for parking (3-14 spaces!) and access to a larger employment pool.

Connect Transit benefits by fulfilling our mission of providing access to opportunity, strengthening the economy of our community, and improving the environment. Connect Transit will also meet additional federal requirements, which will attract performance related funding that can be used to provide other services without burdening the City or the Town. Connect Transit will provide a \$500 subsidy per vehicle and has contracted with Commute with Enterprise, a national vanpool coordination firm with over 1,200 clients, to provide the coordination, vehicle, insurance, and maintenance.

Dear EnviroBusinessOwner.

There are a few ways to encourage riding the bus. One is to offer a subsidy to make access easier, whether that's signing a Universal Access Agreement with Connect or buying passes to offer your employees at a discount. The IRS gives a pretax transit benefit that you can offer to employees who use public transit: https://www.irs.gov/publications/p15b#en_US_2022_publink1000193743.
